The following amendment is made for the posts of Assistant Professor in the College of Fisheries:

- (a) In the discipline of Fisheries Resource Management at Sl. No 6 the number of posts should be read as 2 (two) one in the Scheduled Caste Category and other in the Unreserved category.
- (b) At Sl. No. 2 the qualification for the post of Assistant Professor (Aquaculture) should be read as Master's degree in Aquaculture/Fish Genetics and Biotechnology/Fish Genetics and Breeding/Fish Biotechnology with at least 60% marks or equivalent grade point and having relevant basic degree of 4 years Bachelor's in Fisheries Science (B.F.Sc.).
- (c) At Sl. No. 8 the qualification for the post of Assistant Professor (Aquaculture) should be read as Master's Degree in Aquaculture/Fish Nutrition and Biochemistry/Fish Nutrition, Physiology and Biochemistry/Fish Nutrition and Feed Technology/Fish Biochemistry subject with at least 60% marks or equivalent grade point and having relevant basic degree of 4 years Bachelor in Fisheries Science (B.F.Sc.)

Other qualification will remain the same.

2. The scheme of examination for the post of Assistant Professor shall be as under:
1. Selection will be made as per the following  
Score Card will be given 25% weightage, written examination 50% and Presentation and interview 25% weightage

2. Academic Score will be calculated as under:

**Academic Score:**

$0.05 \times \% \text{ marks of High School} + 0.10 \times \% \text{ marks of } +2/ \text{ Intermediate} + 0.15 \times \% \text{ marks of Graduation} + 0.20 \times \% \text{ marks of Master's degree} + 10 \text{ Marks for Ph.D (Maximum 50 marks)}$


+ **15 Marks** for experience (5 marks per year)

+ **10 marks** for award (JLN award or equivalent – 10 marks, Best paper etc. – 02 marks each + **25 marks** for publication (Sum of NAAS rating of publication) + **02 marks** for presented papers, bulletins, book chapter etc. with a maximum of 10 marks )

- (a) Examination level will be Masters course for subject matter.  
(b) language (English) for +2 level and  
(c) GK test will be for varied subjects for which knowledge is expected from Agricultural Professional
