Research Activities

> Preservation of Cauliflower Curd by Deep Freezing

The preservation of cauliflower curds by deep freezing technique has been standardized at Post harvest Lab, Department of Horticulture, TCA, Dholi. So far, cauliflower curds exhibited shelf life of 6 months, when stored at -20 °C temperature. This technology is yet to be released by the University.

Demonstration of Hand-tool for Okra Harvesting

A hand tool for okra (*bhindi*) harvesting developed by CAET Pusa, which was approved by the Research Council of RPCAU, was post to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and Director Research appreciated the tools and suggested the ways and means of dissemination this harvesting tool among farmers.
