(i) AGE LIMIT

- At least 21 years of age as on 31.08.2022 but not more than 50 years are eligible to apply for the examination.
- No relaxation is admissible regarding the minimum age limit.

Selection procedures as approved by the Board of Management

(a) Academic Attainments (record)

Weightage for academic attainments (High School to terminal degree) would be 70%.

(b) Interview

The weightage for interview is 30%. Candidates will be called for on- line/ offline interview in the ratio of maximum 1:4 (No. of seats: No. of students called for interview) or less in case to case basis.

Selection of candidate will be based on academic score as per guideline framed by the University and personal interview. The weightage of Academic score and personal interview will be 70:30. The entire process will be done through a selection committee. Final selection will be based on cumulative score. The decision of the University selection committee will be final. All the Ph.D. candidates will have to show a power point presentation on his future work plan.

A student selected under this category will have to abide by all the rules and regulations applicable to a student under normal category.
